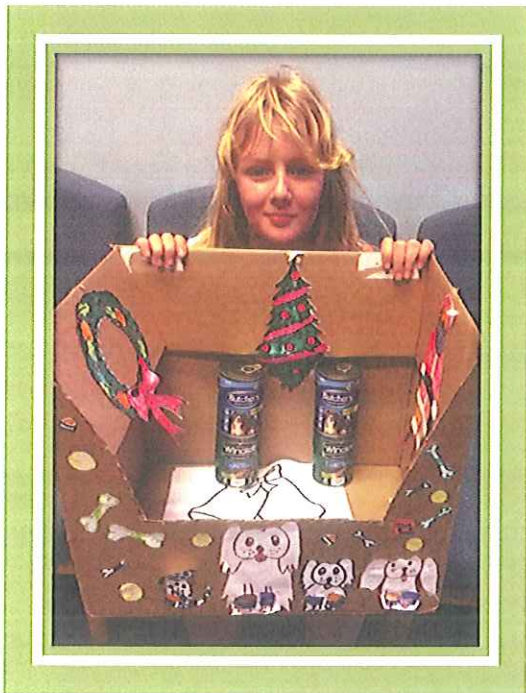


Congratulations to Miss Collins from Year 1 who had a gorgeous baby boy last week named Jamie.

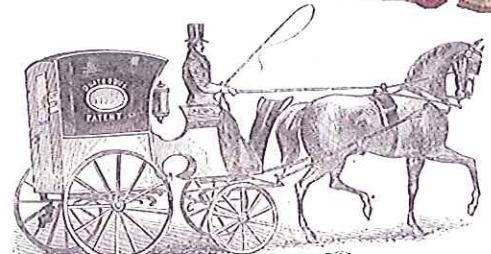
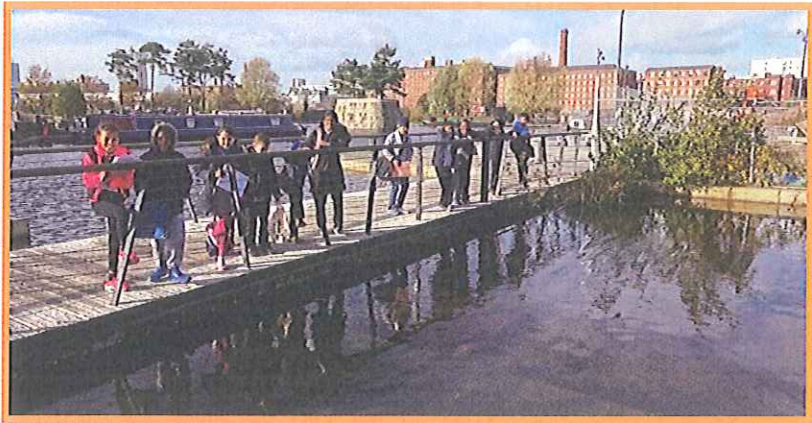
