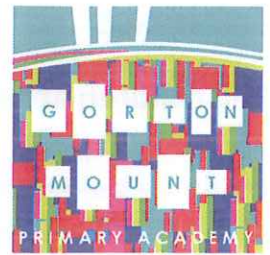
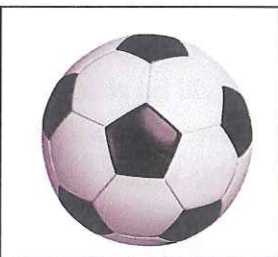

Workshop

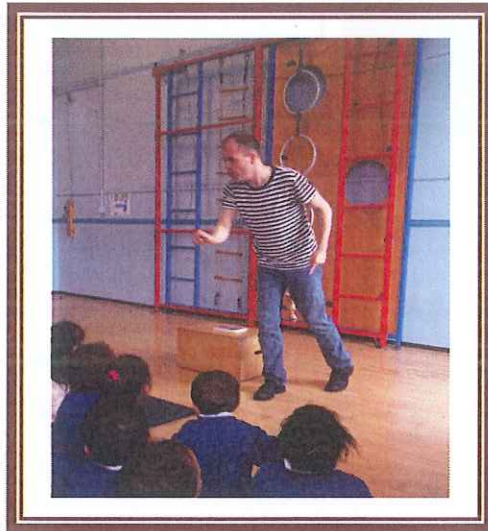
